Fans of The Hideout Grill will be glad to hear that the raised gardens have been constructed and a bounty of vegetables and herbs have been planted to bring even more farm-to-table goodness to this popular restaurant.

Here's the roster of plants already flourishing out here in the Texas Hill Country: beefsteak tomatoes, peppers, cabbage, lettuce, berries, yellow heirloom/cherry/grape tomatoes, zucchini and yellow squash, green onions, radishes, carrots, beets, melons and cucumbers. Adding to the flavor will be a harvest of herbs like cilantro, parsley, mint, basil, dill, oregano, lamb's ear sage and lemon English thyme.

The Hideout Smoked Burger

These hearty burgers begin with a blend of brisket and ground chuck, which we cold smoke for one hour with oak chips. We then double grind and hand patty them and cook over our mesquite fried grill. The burgers are served with lettuce, onion and tomatoes on a toasted brioche bun with a side of our house-made Kennebec french fries.

In the last couple of days, we have seen an abundance of growth in the new Hideout garden. We're excited about the whole new world of freshness represented in the 12 raised-bed gardens behind the clubhouse, surrounded by amazing Austin stone walls and steel gates. There is so much exciting progress to report this month at The Hideout Golf Club & Resort that is making this great destination even better!

In particular, work on the resort amenities is moving along nicely. The indoor restoration is now complete on the Fitness Center, so the fitness equipment can be installed upon arrival. The sports courts have been leveled and prepared for concrete – ready for tennis, pickleball and basketball before you know it! The poolside snack bar and restrooms are under construction, as is the Halfway House on the golf course and a full bath house for golfers and the RV Park. In addition, the firepit areas and lower deck entertainment areas are nearing completion.

Things are busy at the King's Point Cove neighborhood too. Water and sewer lines are now complete and have been approved by the engineer and Brooksmith Water Supply Corp. In fact, Brooksmith has already installed two water meters for property owners this week. In addition, the base is currently being laid for the first mile of roads in the neighborhood. Paving should begin by the middle of June.
