ON THE GRILL -

Pappardelle with Braised Short Ribs and Smoked Tomato Ragout

Watch for this and other exciting menu additions coming soon to the Hideout Grill!

Short ribs slow braised until fork tender (approximately 4 hours) with red wine, aromatic herbs and vegetables. Pecan wood-smoked ripe tomatoes simmered with the beef cooking liquids; puréed, strained and then simmered till rich and thick. Pappardelle noodles cooked al dente, drained and tossed with fresh butter and Parmesan cheese. Top noodles with sliced short ribs, smother with the smoked tomato ragout, sprinkle with a bit more Parmesan and serve.



MIXOLOGY

Old Fashions have been the topic of discussion in bars throughout history. Do you muddle fruit? Does it have a cherry? Do you use an orange wedge? Extra fine sugar or simple syrup? The questions have been asked a million times! Well the proper way to 'fashion' an Old Fashion is as follows: 1 sugar cube, 2 dashes of bitters, splash of water to dissolve the sugar, 2 oz of good bourbon, and an orange 'twist'. The twist is simply the peel of an orange twisted over the glass to release the oils. Drop the orange twist in and top with ice. This classic cocktail pairs well with hearty meals, such as braise short ribs. The bourbon and citrus cut down the richness of the ribs! Enjoy!!
